



## **Transition to Hybrid Learning**

- Cohort A (Last Names A-L) starts attending in person on October 12th.
- Cohort B (Last Names M-Z) DO NOT attend on campus until October 15th. Attend classes via Zoom October 12th and 13th.
- See the [Silver Springs Hybrid Bell Schedule](#) for class period times.
- Please do not arrive on campus on non designated days. Cohort A = Mondays/Tuesdays, Cohort B = Thursdays/Fridays, Full Distance = no on campus days.
- All visitors (staff, students, parents, public) must check in with the front office upon arrival.
- All students must wear masks consistent with the District's [Facial Covering Policy](#) and maintain [Physical Distancing](#) which means 6 feet from other people.
- Students who refuse to wear face coverings shall have the option to participate in distance education. Accommodations will be made for special education students with medical/behavioral conditions, based on physician input.
- All students must complete the District's [COVID-19 Daily Symptom Checklist](#) prior to arrival to school.
- All students need to bring their charged Chromebooks to school with them.
- Breakfast will be provided prior to the start of school (8:30am - 9am) for students to eat outside.
- Students are required to submit the online Symptom Check form (located in Student Bookmarks) prior to the start of their first period of the day. Students are to display their results to their teacher - students who indicate they are experiencing symptoms (with a screen that displays a red STOP sign) shall be

referred to the Health Office. Students who display a green check mark shall enter class and begin their school day.

- Classroom desks will be arranged with space for appropriate physical distancing per local and state public health guidance.
- Classrooms are being outfitted with wet wipes for students to wipe down their desks and chairs at the end of the class period.
- Floor markings and directional arrows will be provided as visual identifiers for maintaining appropriate physical distancing.
- In order to best facilitate contact tracing, students will be assigned a classroom seat / desk, which should remain consistent to the extent possible.
- Drinking fountains have been turned off as a precautionary measure to address the spreading of droplets. Students are encouraged to bring their own water to school. Where possible, fillable water bottle hydration stations will be left on.
- A grab and go lunch will be provided at the end of the school day (12:14pm-12:24pm) prior to bus departure.
