PUBLIC MEETING

3:23pm - Call to Order by Randy

3:24pm - Distribution of minutes from 02.28.20. Reviewed minutes - motion to approve by Bethany - seconded and unanimously approved.

3:26pm - Introductions

PUBLIC FORUM

3:28pm - Invitation to members of the public to address the School Site Council with issues that are not on the agenda. - None

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

3:28pm - Counseling - Bethany reported that Silver Springs has 214 active students with several on the waitlist. A lot of concerns about if students are making progress. We're trying to think of ways to better support our students. We have 115 seniors and we will see that number grow as we get closer to graduation as more will transfer. We will also see some students graduate by December.

REPORTS

3:35pm - Principal/Assistant Principal, Essential Outcomes - Scott explained the Essential Outcomes Progress Update from 19/20. Marty shared some of the data from last year's Healthy Kids Survey that indicated that a majority of our students feel safe and connected at Silver Springs. Marty talked about one of our goals being to improve student attendance. Bethany proposed that goals be focused on our needs this year such as student mental health and the increased failure rate.

OLD BUSINESS

3:51pm - Resources/Needs identified in the past two years (per WASC, Site Council) - Scott introduced Silver Springs' new WASC coordinator, India Greeley. Marty explained what WASC stands for and what it entails.

NEW BUSINESS

3:53pm - COVID-19 Hybrid Instruction Update - Marty explained cohorts A, B, C. He said we average about 40 students on campus per day. Generally 3-6 students per class. Scott talked about the Q1 Analysis Survey that was taken by staff last week. The survey was used to identify reasons why students are struggling/failing and rank potential solutions.

4:05pm - Scott talked about the 2 major changes for 2020/21 which were that Silver combined with NU Tech and the Silver Springs Bell Schedule is now 7 periods.

4:06pm - 2019/20 School Plan for Student Achievement Revisions - Scott explained that this is updated annually. It includes the school's funds and expenditures. There were some pieces left out of this report that have now been added. Randy made a motion to approve the revision - Jenn seconded the motion - unanimously approved.
